

BY-LAW NO. 600

A By-Law of the Town of Wembley in the Province of Alberta to regulate smoking in Town owned facilities and motorized equipment.

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Wembley to prohibit or regulate smoking in Town owned facilities and motorized equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Wembley, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "No Smoking By-Law".
2. In this By-law:
  - a) "Town" means Town of Wembley.
  - b) "Smoke" or "Smoking" includes the use or carrying a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted smoking equipment.
  - c) "Private function" means a private function for which a room or hall has been exclusively reserved by an individual or group and is attended by people who are specifically invited.
3. No person shall smoke in the Wembley Community Hall unless it is being used for a private function and the renters have indicated that they desire to permit smoking.
4. The following buildings and/or facilities are included in the provisions of this by-law:
  - a) Wembley Municipal Building located on Lot 13, Block 5, Plan 782 0853
  - b) Fire Hall located on Lot 24, Block 4, Plan 3255 CL.
  - c) All Works and Utilities Buildings located on Lot 4, Block 20, Plan 782 0990.
  - d) Water Treatment Reservoirs located on Lot 25, Block 4, Plan 3255 CL and Lot 9 to 11, Block 5, Plan 782 0853.
  - e) Sewage Treatment Facility located on Lot 9, Block 21, Plan 782 0881.
  - f) Well Facility located on road allowance 3358 CL.
  - g) All motorized vehicles and equipment registered to or leased by the Town.
5. Any person who smokes in contravention of the By-law is guilty of an offence and, on summary conviction, is liable to a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), exclusive of costs.
6. This By-law shall take effect on the date on January 1, 1997.

READ a first, second, and by unanimous consent of all Councillors present, a third and final time this 9th day of December, A.D. 1996.
