

TOWN OF WEMBLEY  
BY-LAW 642

A By-law of the Town of Wembley, in the Province of Alberta, to require every nomination to be accompanied by a deposit for all candidates for election to the Council of the Town of Wembley.

Whereas Section 29 of the Local Authorities Election Act provides that an elected authority may require every nomination to be accompanied by a deposit in the amount specified by by-law.

Now therefore the Council of the Town of Wembley being duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Municipal Election Candidates Deposit By-Law".
2. Every nomination paper required by the Local Authorities Election Act which nominates a candidate for election as a member of the Council of the Town of Wembley presented to the Returning Officer for the municipal election shall be accompanied by a deposit in the amount of \$100.00.
3. The deposit must be provided in cash, by certified cheque or money order payable to the Town of Wembley.
4. The deposit will be held in trust by the Returning Officer and returned at such time as the candidate is elected, withdraws his/her name as a candidate for the office of which he/she was so nominate or obtains a number of votes at least equal to one half of the total number of votes polled for the candidate elected.
5. This by-law shall take effect on final reading thereof and shall replace By-law number 386.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF ALL THE COUNCILLORS PRESENT, A THIRD AND FINAL READING AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 16TH DAY OF JULY, 2007.
