A By-Law for the Town of Wembley in the Province of Alberta being By-Law No. 531.

WHEREAS Sections 117 &118 of the Municipal Taxation Act being Chapter M-31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 provides that a council may impose a penalty for non-payment of taxes:

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Wembley in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

- (1) On the fourth day of August, a penalty of eighteen percent will be applied to all taxes that remained unpaid on the first day of August in the year in which they are levied.
- (2) On the fourth day of January, a penalty of eighteen percent will be applied to all taxes that remain unpaid on the thirty first day of December of the year for which they are levied and in each following year thereafter so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

This by-law comes into effect upon the date of the third and final reading and therewith recinds all preceeding tax penalty by-laws.
