# 12.12.1 September 23, 2020 Meeting Minutes

Discussion around the feasibility of the current campground and upgrades needed versus elimination and rejuvenation of the green space was not taken lightly. After review of the former budgets and revenue generated from the seven-stall campground along with the costs associated with up grading from 15 amp to 30-amp power, fire pit replacements, new tables and sites floated. Noting also that there are two campgrounds within 15minutes of the location and the potential of a third just minutes away, corresponding with the low numbers of users. It is under the recommendation of the Parks and Recreation committee to dissolve the existing campground and follow through with the rejuvenation project benefiting our residents to a higher degree.
