  - Economic and Social Impacts of the Reduction in Provincial Government Funding

     need to make in order to adjust to the reduction in funding.
  - Restoring the Alberta Advantage representatives of Alberta business and economic development communities shared how the revenue pressures on municipalities impact private investment. Recommendations on how municipalities and the provincial government can assist in bringing back the Alberta Advantage were discussed.
