

BY- LAW NUMBER 424

A By-Law for the Village of Wembley being
By- Law Number 424.

Passed in accordance with Section 152 of the
Municipal Government Act.

The Council of Village of Wembley, being duly
assembled, enacts as follows:

- a) no drunkenness, swearing, obscene, offensive
insulting language, fighting Or disorderly
conduct will be allowed on or near any street
or in any public place or building within the
Village of Wembley, or in any place to which
the public has access,
- b) the sale of firecrackers or fireworks be
prohibited to persons under the age of 18 years.
- c) and regulating the firing off of firecrackers
or fireworks and
- d) prohibiting the discharge of guns or other
firearms in any specified part or parts of
the Village of Wembley.

Received first, and second reading, and by
unanimous consent of the Councillors present, a
third reading and finally passed this 24th day
of September, 1975.
