

A By-law of the Town of Wembley, in the Province of Alberta authorizing the establishment of a Community Hall Board for the Wembley Community Hall.

In accordance with Section 115 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, Council of the Town of Wembley hereby establish a Community Hall Board.

The Community Hall Board shall consist of the seven members of the Town Council.

The members will serve on the board for a term coinciding with their term of office as mayor or councillor for the Town of Wembley.

A minute book shall be kept and the minutes of all regular and special meetings shall be recorded by the secretary of the Community Hall Board.

A quorum of the Board shall be a majority of the members of the Community Hall Board.

The Chairman shall have a vote on any question and in the event of a tie, the motion will be lost.

The Community Hall Board shall have the power to make such rules and regulations as it may deem necessary from time to time, provided such rules and regulations are not inconsistent with powers herein conferred. Copies of such rules and regulations shall be recorded in the minutes and shall be posted in the Hall.

An accurate and complete record of all expenditures and income shall be kept. A financial statement as of December 31, of each year shall be recorded in the minutes.

The Community Hall Board shall be concerned with the equipping, maintenance, leasing and general governing of activities in, and pertaining to the Wembley Community Hall.

No member of the Community Hall Board shall have the power to pledge the credit of the Town of Wembley with any matters whatsoever, nor have any power to authorize any expenditure to be charged against the Town of Wembley.

This bylaw hereby recinds all previous bylaws pertaining to the establishment of a Community Hall Board.
