3. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

3.1 Strategic Plan

Mr. Tim Duhamel was present, via Zoom, to query whether Council agreed with the priorities and objectives of the Strategic Plan or would Council like to see something added or deleted. Council stated that there were still several formatting issues, and some typing errors, that needed to be addressed.

Councillor Underwood queried what a "internet hub" was. Mr. Duhamel explained it was a gathering place, which contained computers accessible to the public, where people can play games, access education programs, as a group activity. Council asked that this item be moved to Healthy Communities.

3.2 General Traffic Bylaw

Council went through the General Traffic Bylaw and the following issues were discussed:

- Section 12. b. ii Council had a problem with commercial vehicles having thirty
 (30) minutes to load/unload in alleys but citizens only have ten (10) minutes to
 load/unload. Council directed Administration to change wording to read one (1)
 hour maximum for loading/unloading, for citizens, and the vehicle must remain
 operable.
- Speed Limits discussion centered on lowering the speed limit to 30 km/h throughout all of Wembley. This item will be brought forward to the February 7, 2022 Council meeting.
- CAO Zhang also explained to Committee that one of the additions to the General Traffic Bylaw will be a Short- and Long-Term Road Permit as well as the Master Road Use Agreement. This item will also be brought forward to the February 7, 2022 Council meeting.
